BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fair Housing Officer will serve as the primary point of contract for any fair housing issues between the public and locality.



RESOLUTION #10 APPROVIING SNOW REMOVAL AND ICE CONTROL CONTRACT
BETWEEN COIUNTY OF ALLEGANY AND THE TOWN OF HUME

Pursuant to Highway Law Section 135-a

WHEREAS, a Contract has been proposed between the County of Allegany and the Town of Hume for the removal of snow from County Roads within the Town of Hume and for sanding or otherwise treating them for the purpose of removing the danger of snow and ice, and

WHEREAS, the Allegany County Board of Legislators did approve said Contract by Resolution passed on May 29th, 2025, and

WHEREAS, this Board feels that the terms and conditions of said Contract are fair and equitable, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED:

1. That the proposed Snow Removal and Ice Control Contract between the County of Allegany the Town of Hume, New York, for each mile contained in Appendix A County Road for the three (3) seasons beginning with the 2025-2026 snow season and ending with the 2027-2028 snow season, are approved.
2. That the Supervisor of this Town is authorized and directed to execute the said Contract in duplicate and the Town Clerk is directed to file one of the duplicate original contracts in his or her office and to send a certified copy of this Resolution to the Clerk of the Allegany County Board of legislators for filing in her office.
